## **OBSERVER CHECKLIST**

To start clinical observation hours at Enloe Health, you must register with the Enloe Health Education Center. Please email <a href="mailto:students@enloe.org">students@enloe.org</a> with the subject line "Observation Hours." Once you receive a reply and are registered, please complete the checklist below.

	<b>Collect proof of ALL of the following immunizations.</b> Please compare the following list to your records to be sure you meet all the requirements.	
		<b>TB (tuberculosis)</b> – If you have not had a TB test in the last 12 months, you will need to complete one at least seven days before your intake date. Most university health centers will administer this test for you. A copy of your negative results page will be required at intake.
		<b>COVID-19</b> – Proof of COVID-19 immunization - Proof of being fully vaccinated, which occurs two weeks after the second dose in a two-dose series, i.e., Pfizer or Moderna, or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine, i.e., the Janssen vaccine.
		☐ In accordance with the Public Health Order issued Dec. 22, 2021, CDPH is requiring HCP to be up to date with vaccinations and receive boosters by March 1, 2022, or when eligible.
		<b>MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) –</b> You must have two vaccinations or provide proof of positive titer results. You can obtain a titer, to determine if you have immunity to these, by having a blood draw at a lab.
		<b>Tdap –</b> You must have the adult dose at 19 years and a booster every 10 years. Please verify the date on your records to be sure it meets these requirements.
		<b>Varicella –</b> You must have two vaccinations or provide proof of positive titer results. You can obtain a titer, to determine if you have immunity to these, by having a blood draw at a lab.
		<b>Flu</b> – This is required for those with assignments that overlap the dates of Oct. 1 through March 31. Enloe Health offers free vaccination at public clinics in the fall. Be sure to keep your documentation as proof.
		<b>Hepatitis B –</b> You can either have proof of three shots on your immunization or proof of a positive titer. There is an option to decline.
	<b>Following collection of your immunization records,</b> schedule your Education/Health Clearance Appointment at least seven days after your TB test is read. To schedule the appointment, call 530-332-7366.	
	<b>Complete your Education/Health Clearance appointment.</b> This is when you will sign all confidentiality forms, show your photo ID and receive a Health Clearance Form you will take to Employee Health. Caregivers will examine your immunization records and may administer a second TB test.	
	Ref	turn to have your TB test read 48 hours after your Education/Health Clearance Appointment.  Surn your Health Clearance Form to the Education Center for your final clearance. The Enloe Health host partment may require an orientation prior to starting your observation experience.
A f	ace	mask is required at all clearance appointments, as well as during your clinical observation hours.
